In reference to your conversation with the Providence Resident Agency of the FBI on July 25, 2008, please be advised your complaint pertains to matters which are still pending in Bankruptcy Court. As you are aware, any billing disputes or expenses of trustees must be approved by the court and can be appealed if you feel they were not appropriate.

Please be assured that we have an excellent working relationship with the Bankruptcy Court. If the Bankruptcy Court believes any type of fraud has occurred, they will notify the U.S. Attorney's Office and the FBI. Inasmuch as there is not a final disposition in your bankruptcy matter, your claim of missing assets is indeterminable.

In view of the above, no further action will be taken by the FBI at this time.
